Dr. Harned is the Coordinator of the DBT Program at the VA Puget Sound Health Care System, Seattle Division. She is also an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences and an Adjunct Associate Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of Washington. Previously, Dr. Harned served as the Research Director of Dr. Marsha Linehan's Behavioral Research and Therapy Clinics (2006-2018), Director of Research and Development at Behavioral Tech (2014-2017), and Director of Behavioral Tech Research (2013-2016). Her research has focused on developing and evaluating the DBT Prolonged Exposure protocol for PTSD as well as strategies for implementing evidence-based treatments into clinical practice. She regularly provides training and consultation nationally and internationally in DBT and DBT PE and has published extensively on these treatments. Dr. Harned is licensed as a psychologist in the state of Washington, certified as a DBT Clinician by the DBT-Linehan Board of Certification, certified as a PE therapist and supervisor, and board certified in Behavioral and Cognitive Psychology.
